## WHAT IS HAPPENING IN 1/2T?

In STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) lessons this year, students in Class 1/2T have been learning how to code Bee Bots. They have planned the algorithms and tested their plans. Engineers don't always get it right the first time and then they alter their plans to try again. This is a valuable lesson for our students to learn.



1/2T are also learning how to code with the computer program Scratch. The students can make virtual objects move by creating a sequence of steps. They can also add background, speech and music and thoroughly enjoy learning with technology.
