There is an order form attached to this newsletter if you need another one. Remember orders can be placed at anytime and P&C will fill them as soon as they can, not just on shop open days.

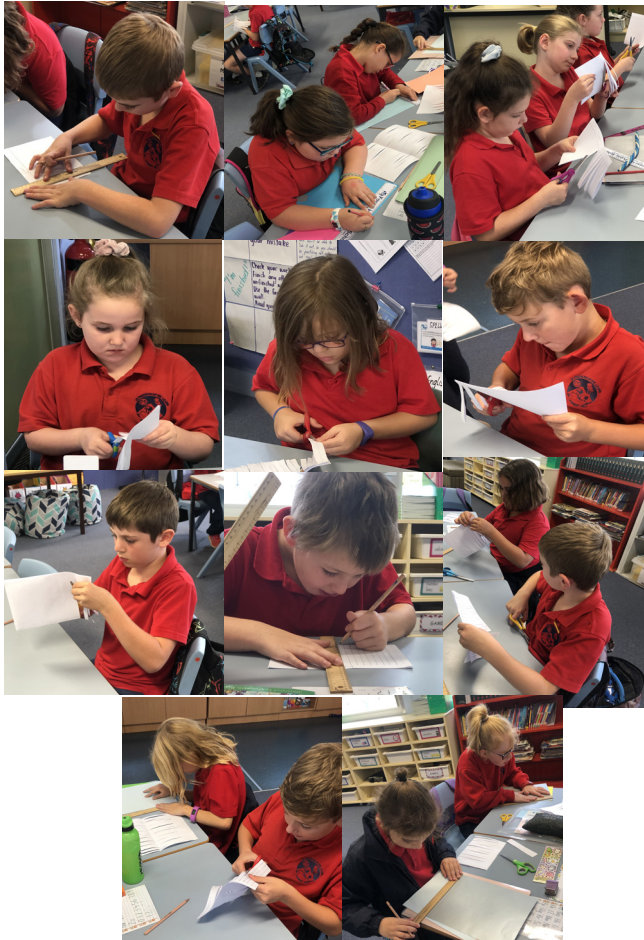
