Could you please fill in and return to the office as soon as possible. This will help to ensure our student/family details are correct and funding for the school is accurate

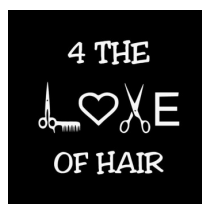
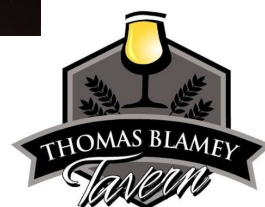
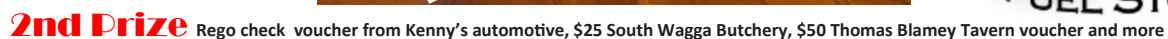
## SPOTLIGHT ON 5/6D
