For Fathers Day we mixed ingredients and chilled them. We hope they enjoyed their treats.




## 1/2T Cont.

Look at these faces made from a recycled egg carton. We studied the 3D shapes in the egg carton and created facial features by trimming and gluing them together.





## JUMP OFF DAY



Leave us the plastic lids from your milk, water, juice and soft drink bottles and they'll be converted into prosthetic hands for kids.



Bullying is when someone or a group of people who have more power than you, **repeatedly** use words or actions to hurt you.

Bullying can happen anywhere – at home, with friends, in a group, at school, on the bus or at school.

### There are many different types of bullying:

#### Verbal

Name calling, teasing, putting someone down, threatening to cause someone harm.

#### Physical

Poking, hitting, punching, kicking, spitting, tripping or pushing someone, breaking someone's things, pulling faces or making rude hand signals.

#### Social

Lying, spreading rumours, playing horrible jokes, leaving someone out on purpose, embarrassing someone in public.

#### Cyberbullying

Using technology to hurt someone else by sending hurtful messages, pictures or comments.
