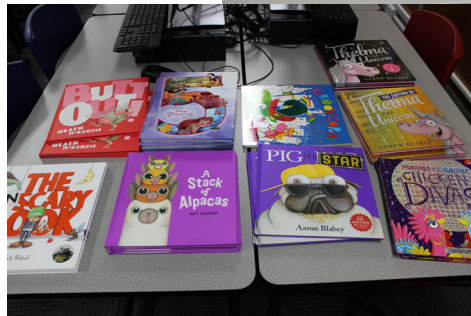

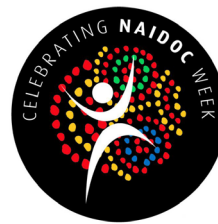
## GYMNASTICS

Forest Hill students are still enjoying learning new skills during their session in the hall. Below are some photos of KR this week.



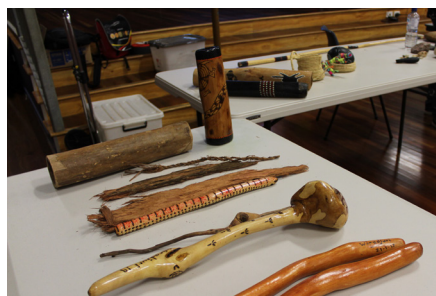
## ROAD SAFETY

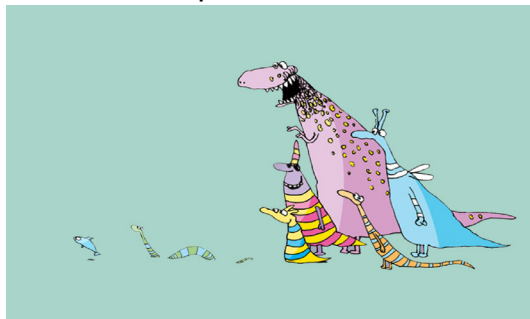




## BOOK WEEK DRESS UP DAY

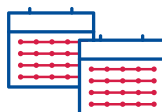
