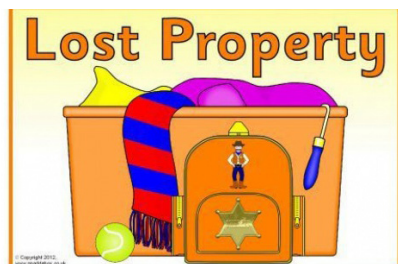
CANTEEN UPDATE

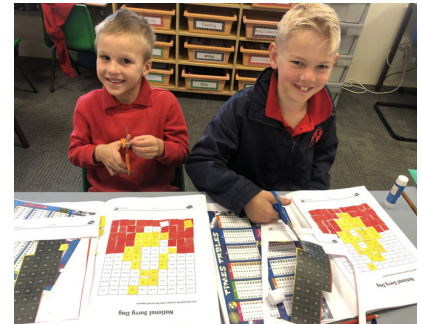
2/3T AND SORRY DAY
