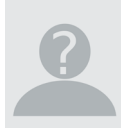

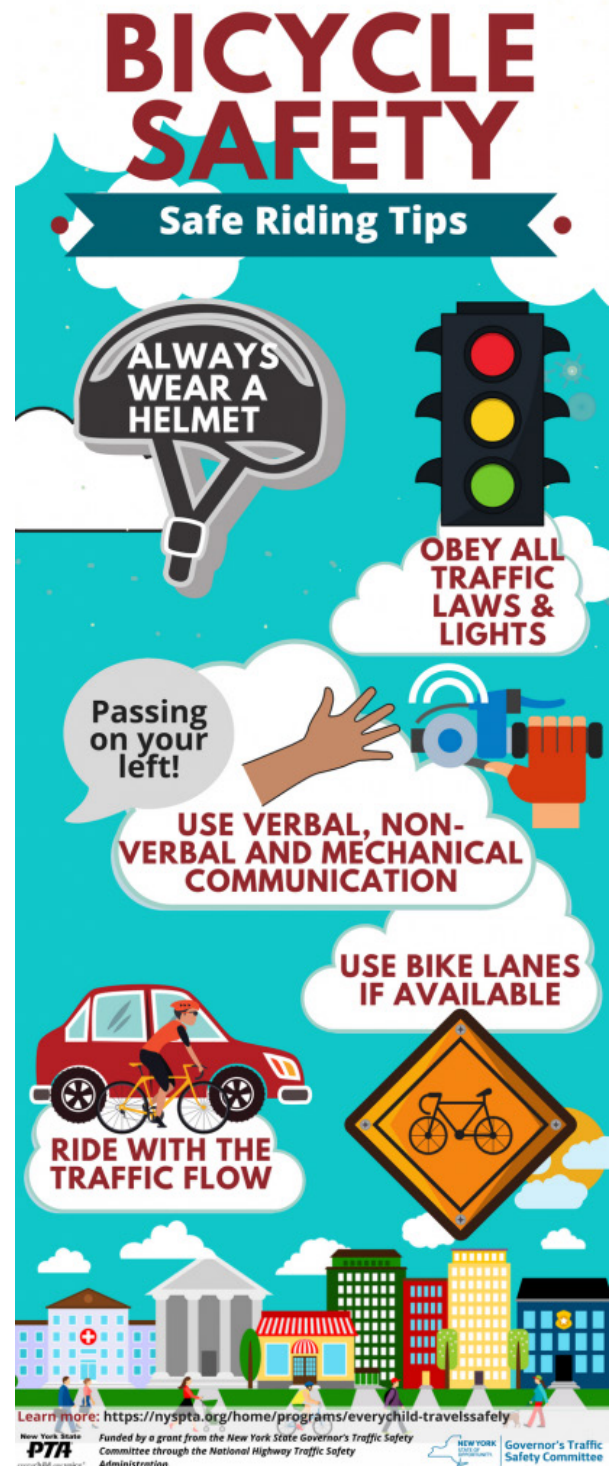


BIKE AND SCOOTER SAFETY
